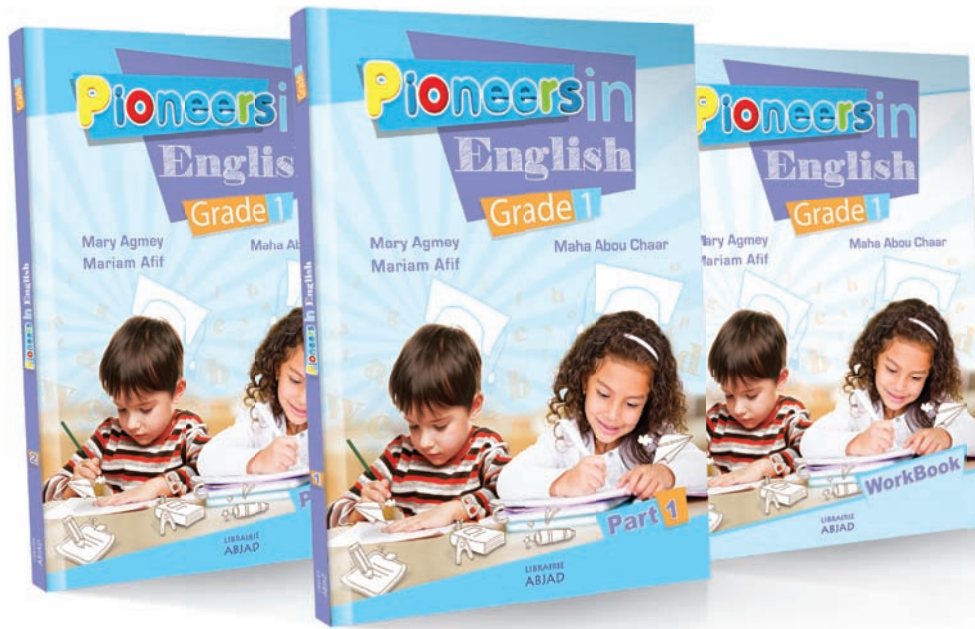


# Pioneers in English Grade 1



Grade one book teaches the English language smoothly. The book begins with simple and easy texts that gradually become harder. Texts become longer to make the students become hooked on reading. After each text, there are comprehension questions that vary from multiple choice questions to true/false questions to short answer questions.

The vocabulary and spelling words are age appropriate and chosen carefully. Students acquire more than 70 new words and learn how to spell more than 160 words. As for the grammar part, the lessons given are up to the grade level. The new words as well as the grammar rules are used later on in writing.

To encourage the student to express themselves, there are group-work activities, speaking activities and listening activities.

Since learning is fun for this age group, the book has many poems, songs and fun activities, such as stickers, coloring, cutting and pasting, and free writing.

For every skill in the book, there are further exercises in the workbook.

Grade one book has a revision book through which students can review the most important KG3 objectives that are prerequisites for grade one..



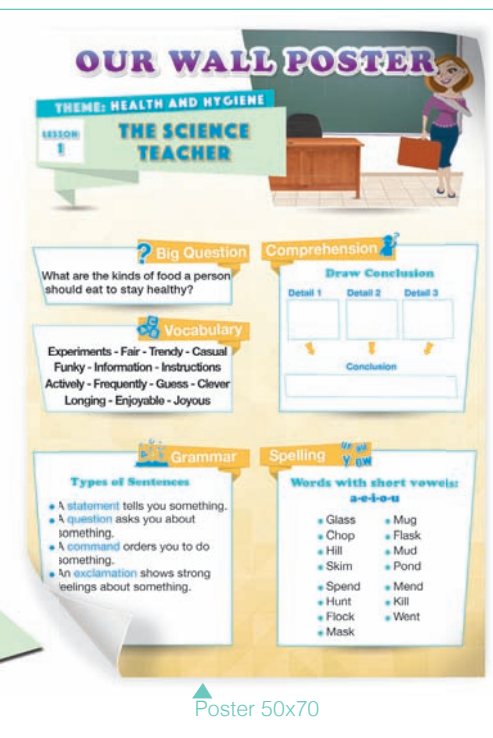

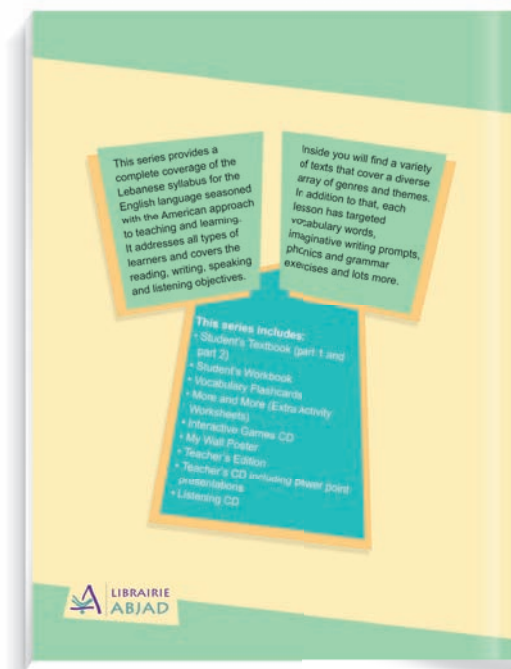

As students become older, lessons become longer and harder. The themes in these grades are chosen carefully. They align with the California standards and follow the Lebanese standards as well. Students get introduced to new skills. They start with harder critical thinking questions that would prepare them for SAT and Brevet exams. After each text, there is a graphic organizer that helps them analyze the text and teaches them a certain reading strategy.

In addition to the vocabulary exercises, vocabulary skill lessons are added which help the students determine meanings of words easily. Grammar and writing lessons become more complicated.

In grade four and grade five students learn idioms. This is added to the book to help students understand spoken English better.

In these grade levels, students learn how to write different types of paragraphs, like narrative and descriptive paragraphs in addition to letters and free writing.

Group-work activities, speaking activities, poetry and listening activities become harder. In listening, students have to answer questions as well as in poetry.

Since this grade is transitional, all the skills for elementary levels are reviewed and new skills for the intermediate level are introduced.

In addition to the reading skill section, there is a literary analysis section. In this part, students learn to differentiate between fiction and non-fiction as literary genres. They also learn to analyze each genre literally.

Poetry is studied in separate lessons. Figures of speech and sound devices are also introduced in this grade.

At the end of this grade, students learn how to write short essays. They are introduced to the essay format and how shift from paragraph to essay.

Idioms in this class are replaced by proverbs that enhance the critical thinking skill of the students.

More exercises that are related to SAT and Brevet exams are added.
